## MOTORS LIST

The EuRoC motors list specifies the available COTS motors to be acquired through the EuRoC official suppliers. Only COTS motors ordered via the official suppliers are permitted. EuRoC organisers will provide more information on the acquisition process, including ordering, transport and payment after selection and acceptance of the teams.

## 1. CESARONI MOTORS

Due to the current global situation, production of rocket motors is being challenged and facing a shortage of propellants ingredients, which led to a decrease of motors availability. Hence, all Cesaroni motors available for EuRoC can be found at the website of the EuRoC's European supplier Euro Space Technology (https://eurospacetechnology.eu/index.php).

## 2. AEROTECH MOTORS

In accordance with USA regulations, the US State Department demands the end user information and an export permit for every single end user. As such, it is not possible for EuRoC organisation to predict the run times for the US State Department permit and only after receiving the permits can production of motors start, with a production lead time of several months. Teams are highly advised to do not pursue with the order of Aerotech motors since there is uncertainty regarding a timely arrival for EuRoC.
